

## **CONTRAINDICATIONS FOR VOTIVA/FORMA V TREATMENT:**

- Active electrical implant in any region of the body
- Under 18 years of age\*
- Vaginal or Pelvic area surgery within the last 3-12 months\*
- Metal implants or mesh in the treatment area\*
- History of genital herpes\*
- Uterine prolapse, cystocele or rectocele greater than Grade 2\*
- Urinary Tract Infection or Pelvic or Pelvic tract infection\*
- Active malignancy or cancer treatment within the last five years\*
- Diseases which may be stimulated by radio frequency\*
- Any active condition in treatment area, such as open lacerations, abrasions or lesions\*
- Pregnancy and nursing\*
- Use of anticoagulants or history of bleeding disorders\*
- Pelvic area lymph node dissection or significant lower lymphatic drainage concerns\*
- Significant illness such as diabetes, cardiac disease, autoimmune disease that may impede wound healing response and interfere with proper recovery\*
- o History of epidermal or dermal disorders involving collagen or microvasculature
- o Diseases of the immune system such as HIV, AIDS or immunosuppressive medications\*

## + CONTRAINDICTIONS FOR MORPHEUS8: EXTERNAL VAGINAL REJUVENATION

- Psoriasis, eczema, or rashes, or herpes simplex virus infection in the treatment zone\*
- o Melanoma or dysplastic nevi
- o History of skin disorders, keloids, abnormal would healing
- Surgical procedure in the treatment area within the last 3 months
- o Treating over Tattoo, permanent makeup, or excessively sun or chemically tanned skin
- History of Accutane or oral corticosteroid use in the previous 6 months\*
- (\*) These conditions will need to be discussed with the Dr. to see if treatment can be performed. In such a case, a small area may be treated and assessed a few days later to determine if you will tolerate the treatment without developing adverse effects.

Note: In case of uncertainty regarding potential side effects, the patient should consult her specialist physician and bring a written consent for treatment
